

Eligibility Criteria for International Elective Rotation:

- Only PGY 2 and above are allowed.
- Fellows must be in their second year of training
- Residents/Fellows must have a faculty advisor at CMH
- Goals and Objectives must be clearly outlined for the experience
- The on site international faculty member who will complete evaluation must be identified
- July month is excluded
- Pre-requisites:
 - Must have regular attendance at required conferences
 - No incomplete rotations
 - Evidence of compliance with documentation of procedures and medical records must be upto date
 - Must have taken In-service exams as appropriate
 - Must have completed required Hopkins Module
 - Must have completed post rotation tests where applicable
 - Must have a call free month available for the international rotation
 - *Program Director has the discretion to determine the number of residents approved for such international rotations including the maximum number that will be gone simultaneously from the program (includes vacations, maternity leave, sickness etc.)*
 - Must have an appointment set with occupational services to meet immediately upon return. This should be within 24 hours or before returning to regular work schedule
- Country of travel should not be listed on the state department travel warning sites
- Must meet with Dr. Ravi Kallur and go through orientation
- Upon return, must meet with PD to go over the experience and to confirm that all goals and objectives of the rotations as stated are met
- Must meet with Ravi Kallur for a debriefing
- Must present the required report and should be willing to make a presentation at a Grand rounds or International day.
