Discord is an online social platform through which groups of people can connect via posts, live video, and more. The nonprofit organization "Diabetes Link" uses the online Discord platform to enable positive peer relationships between young people with Type 1 Diabetes. Diabetes Link also has a huge library of online resources to address all sorts of topics connected to living with diabetes.

About the Experience

The Diabetes Link will create a Discord group just for Children's Mercy teens with Type 1 who participate in this 3 month study experience. There will be weekly prompts to respond to – questions about Travis Kelce and Taylor Swift, low snacks, and anything in between—all are fair game. There will also be about 6 live events when participants can gather online to chat, play a game hosted by a Diabetes Link young adult, and more. Your participation will give you a chance to win a gift card in several raffles throughout the study. The conversation doesn't have to stop there, though. Post questions, concerns, and successes with the group whenever you want, and also respond to your peers. The Diabetes Link can also post great resources from their library when relevant discussions come up.
