Children's Mercy is offering a paid training program for Sterile Processing Technicians. If you're hired, you'll receive a full-time salary and be eligible for benefits during the combined work and training period. After training, you can take the Healthcare Sterile Processing Association certification exam.

Sterile Processing Technicians are critical members of the surgery team and ensure the highest level of sterilization and disinfection of all surgical instruments. Sterile processing positions are in high demand, and Children's Mercy wants to ensure that we have highly trained employees available to do this important work.



How to apply

- Watch for the Sterile Processing Technician I job posting on childrensmercy.org/careers and complete the application.
- We'll review your application and let you know if you're invited for an on-site interview. Finalists will be subject to a background check.
- Training will take place in the fall of 2023 and spring of 2024. After completing 400 hours of work, you'll be eligible to take the Healthcare Sterile Processing Association certification exam. Once you pass it, you'll receive certification pay.
