Fentanyl that is made illegally dominates the street drug supply. It causes a record number of drug deaths in America.

200Over 200 people die every day from overdoses related to synthetic opiods like fentanyl.

3 MAJOR SIGNS OF AN OVERDOSE







Very slow, irregular, or no breathing

Unresponsiveness to pain (breastbone rub)

lips and fingernails Other signs include: Tiny pupils, choking sounds, or a snor-like gurgling noise.

Blue, purple, or gray

Fake pills are made to look like many different types of prescription pills, such as:

- oxycodone (Oxycontin[®] Percocet[®])
- hydrocodone (Vicodin[®])
- alprazolam (Xanax[®])
- other stimulants like amphetamines (Adderall[®])
