



SIM LAB WORKSHOP IN PEDIATRIC BIOETHICS CONSULTATION

Children's Mercy, Department of Bioethics is thrilled to announce a three-day simulation lab in Pediatric Bioethics Consultation. This course will be a small, interactive workshop, based in our simulation laboratory. It is designed to engage the participants by immersing them in realistic, potentially complex ethical cases. This course is unique in that it utilizes simulation to provide a learning by doing environment. Each participant will facilitate their own ethics consultation from start to finish. They will be observed by faculty and remaining participants. After each consult, we will hold a debriefing session to discuss the simulation and what lead you to the outcome as the consultant. The workshop is intended for pediatric health care professionals who now do – or someday hope to do – ethics consultations. The goal is to help individuals become better ethics consultants and provide useful tools to take to take back to their institutions.

OBJECTIVES:

- ❖ Utilize effective communication tools during difficult conversations.
- ❖ Clarify the values and preferences of parents and healthcare professionals while they are immersed in stressful life-altering situations.
- ❖ Achieve shared understanding and consensus for medical management between families and the healthcare team.
- ❖ Make recommendations about how to resolve ethical dilemmas.

DETAILS:

- ❖ The conference will be limited to 12 people.
- ❖ We will use cases based on our own ethics consultation service here at Children's Mercy and some published cases.
- ❖ Each attendee will be assigned a case to which you will serve as the ethics consultant. You will have 30 minutes to interact with actors playing key roles of each case. You will have the option to call upon others (lawyers, chaplains, other team members). The goal for you is to facilitate an ethics consult resulting in a recommendation.
- ❖ We will then have 30 minutes for each simulation to debrief with facilitators, actors and fellow attendees.
- ❖ Didactics will be presented throughout the two days.
- ❖ Webinar
- ❖ Facilitators will all be experienced ethics consultants.
