Are you interested in an internship at the hospital to gain valuable work experience?

Project RISE (Reaching for Independent Successful Employment) offers the Children's Mercy Career Passport Program. This is an opportunity for you to explore career choices and gain valuable work experience through paid internships at the hospital.

About the Career Passport Program

What kind of work will I do?

Interns do a lot of different jobs that help our patients and families. You might do things like:

- Help in an office.
- Show people where to go when they get to Children's Mercy.
- Restock supplies.
- Support the hospital with infection control practices.
- Provide patient and family support.

How long will I be working at Children's Mercy?

The internship program lasts between 8 and 10 weeks.

How many hours will I work each week?

Interns work 12 hours each week.

Which Children's Mercy location will I work from?

All locations are available for interns, so you can choose one that works best for you.
