

Child Sex Trafficking Screen

Scoring Guidance

Questions 1-6

Question	Response	Score	Considerations
1			Although not scored as part of the screening, a positive response should be addressed for safety and to determine any necessary resources.
2	YES	1	Obtain details. There is decreased concern if there was an obvious accident, such as an MVC or a sports injury.
3	YES	1	Consider obtaining details. (How many times? Where did you stay? How did you get food/money? Were you running away from something bad or to something good?)
4	YES	1	Obtain details. Law enforcement involvement for current abuse/assault does not count as a YES.
5	YES to part 5b	1	
6	>5 sex partners <u>or</u> YES to part 6c	1	
Scoring Rule	3 or more points indicate the patient is at risk for sex trafficking		

Questions 7-10

Please note: Questions 7-10 are not scored; actions are based on the patient's response to each question.

Question	Response	Considerations & Actions
7-9	YES to part a but NO to part b	Indicates the patient is at risk and may warrant a response.
7-9	YES to part a AND part b	<u>Trafficking has occurred</u>
10	YES	<u>Trafficking has occurred</u> If a minor reports exchanging sex for the promise of something of monetary value, <i>this must be reported.</i>
