Suspected Conjunctivitis in an Infant ≥ 29 days of age or a Child

Patient off Conjunctivitis guideline,
Refer to Febrile Infant (REVISE) guideline

Is the infant ≥ 29 and ≤ 60 days of age and febrile?

Recommendations for Inclusion or Exclusion from Daycare/School

Does pt. have conjunctival injection, AND mucopurulent discharge or history of glued eyes upon awakening?

Is delayed treatment an option?

- Consider alternative diagnoses:
- Allergies
 - Foreign bodies
 - Uveitis
 - Keratitis
 - [Nasolacrimal duct obstruction](#)
 - [Dacryocystocele](#)

Treat for bacterial conjunctivitis

Delayed Treatment Option

Discharge patient to follow up with either Ophthalmology or primary care provider
