 - Consult cardiology

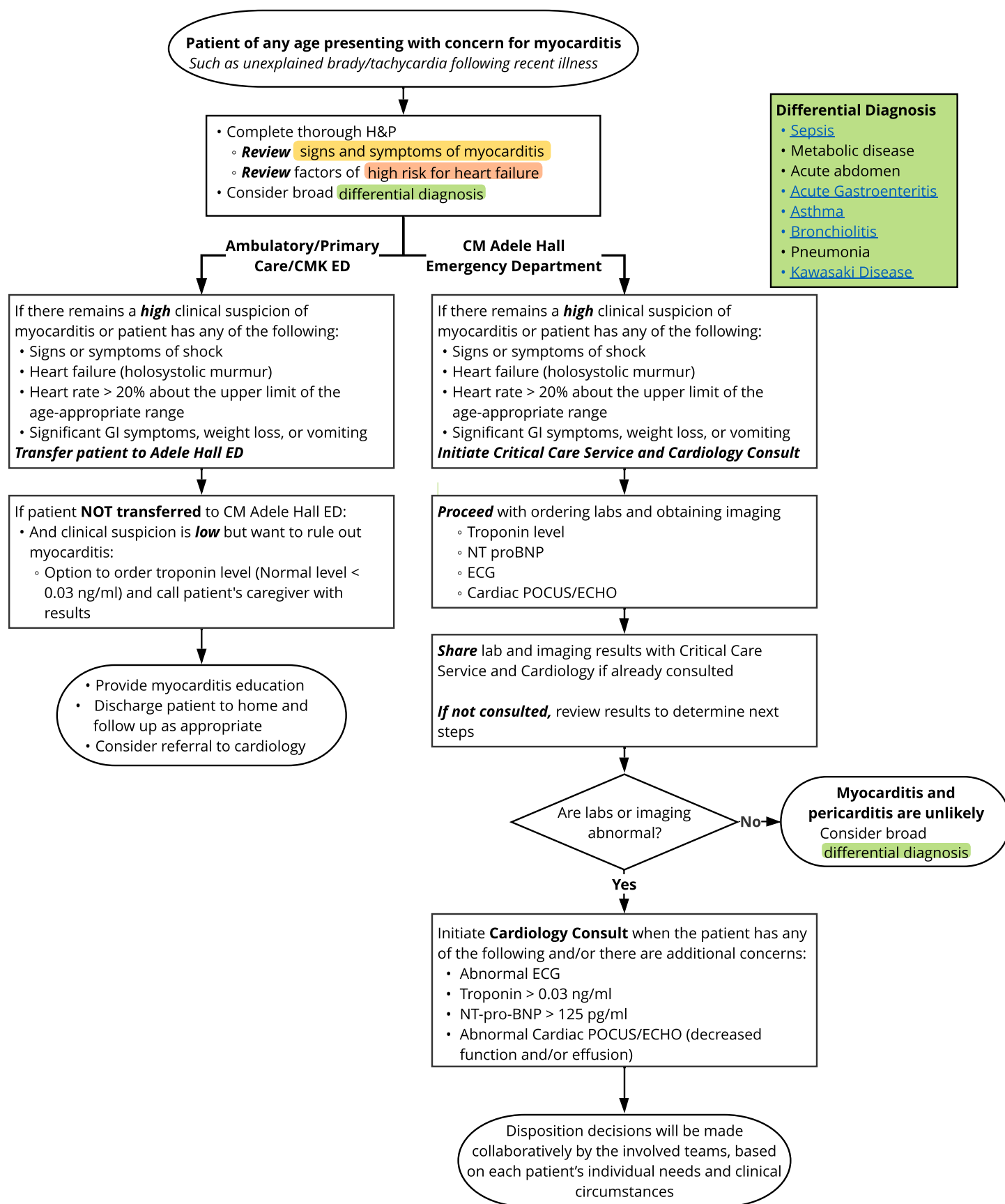
Signs and Symptoms of Myocarditis

- Chest pain
- Palpitations
- Preceding symptoms like fever, fatigue, sore throat, or gastrointestinal issues
- Sudden inability to keep up with normal physical activities due to fatigue or discomfort

High Risk for Acute Heart Failure Due to Myocarditis

- Severe shortness of breath
- Edema in legs, feet, ankles, or face
- Syncope
- Extreme lethargy (extreme sleepiness, unresponsiveness, or poor feeding)
