

Exclusion Criteria:

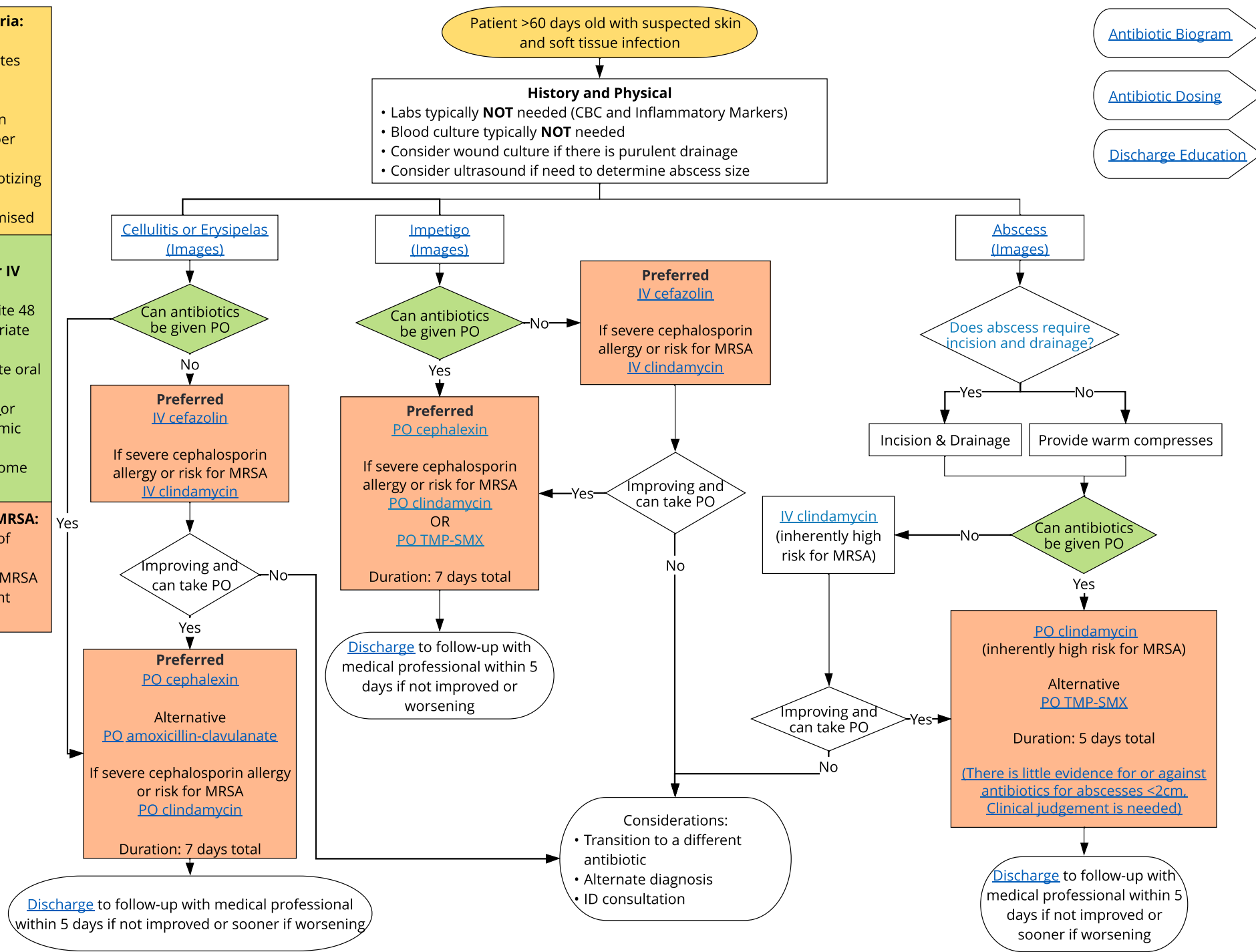
- Suspected sepsis
- Animal/human bites
- Post-surgical site
- Suspected toxin mediated reaction
- Concern for deeper infection
- Concern for necrotizing infection
- Immunocompromised

Indications for IV Antibiotics:

- Worsening despite 48 hours of appropriate oral antibiotics
- Unable to tolerate oral antibiotics
- **Severe infection** or suspected Systemic Inflammatory Response Syndrome

Risk Factors for MRSA:

- Personal history of MRSA
- Family history of MRSA
- Recent or frequent hospitalization
