Suspected Conjunctivitis in an Infant  $\geq 29$  days of age or a Child

Patient off Conjunctivitis guideline,  
Refer to Febrile Infant (REVISE) guideline

Is the infant  $\geq 29$  and  $\leq 60$  days of age and febrile?

Recommendations for Inclusion or Exclusion from Daycare/School

Does pt. have conjunctival injection, AND mucopurulent discharge or history of glued eyes upon awakening?

Is delayed treatment an option?

Consider alternative diagnoses:  
• Allergies  
• Foreign bodies  
• Uveitis  
• Keratitis  
• [Nasolacrimal duct obstruction](#)  
• [Dacryocystocele](#)

Treat for bacterial conjunctivitis

Delayed Treatment Option

Discharge patient to follow up with either Ophthalmology or primary care provider
