TARGET AUDIENCE

This full-day conference is intended for those clinicians who participate in the care of neonates.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- List effective strategies for increasing resilience in our lives.
- Discuss a parent's perspective in the NICU and caring for patients and families.
- Describe the usefulness of continuous glucose monitoring in management of hyperglycemia in an acutely ill neonate.
- Discuss the benefits and limitations of commonly ordered genetic tests for a neonate.
- Recognize the mechanisms by which preterm brain injury occurs and how prospective strategies of care may minimize the risks of injury in the very preterm infant.
- Determine differential diagnosis through assessment.
- Determine optimal decision on treatment of PDAs now that we have devices designed specifically for neonates.
- Define delirium.
- Discuss prevention, recognition, and management of delirium.

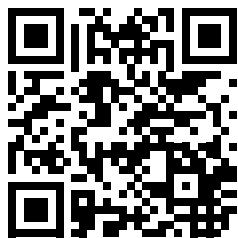
