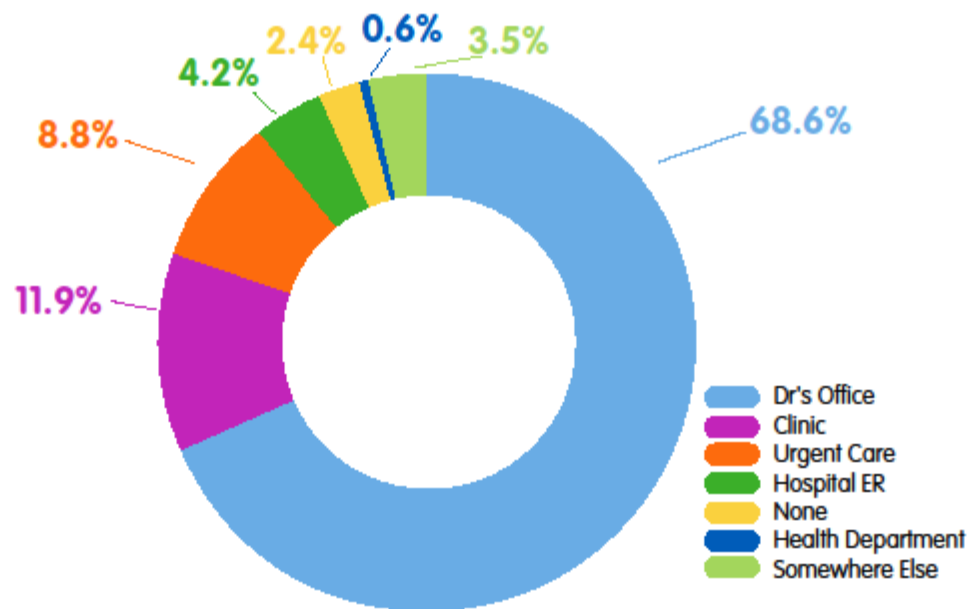

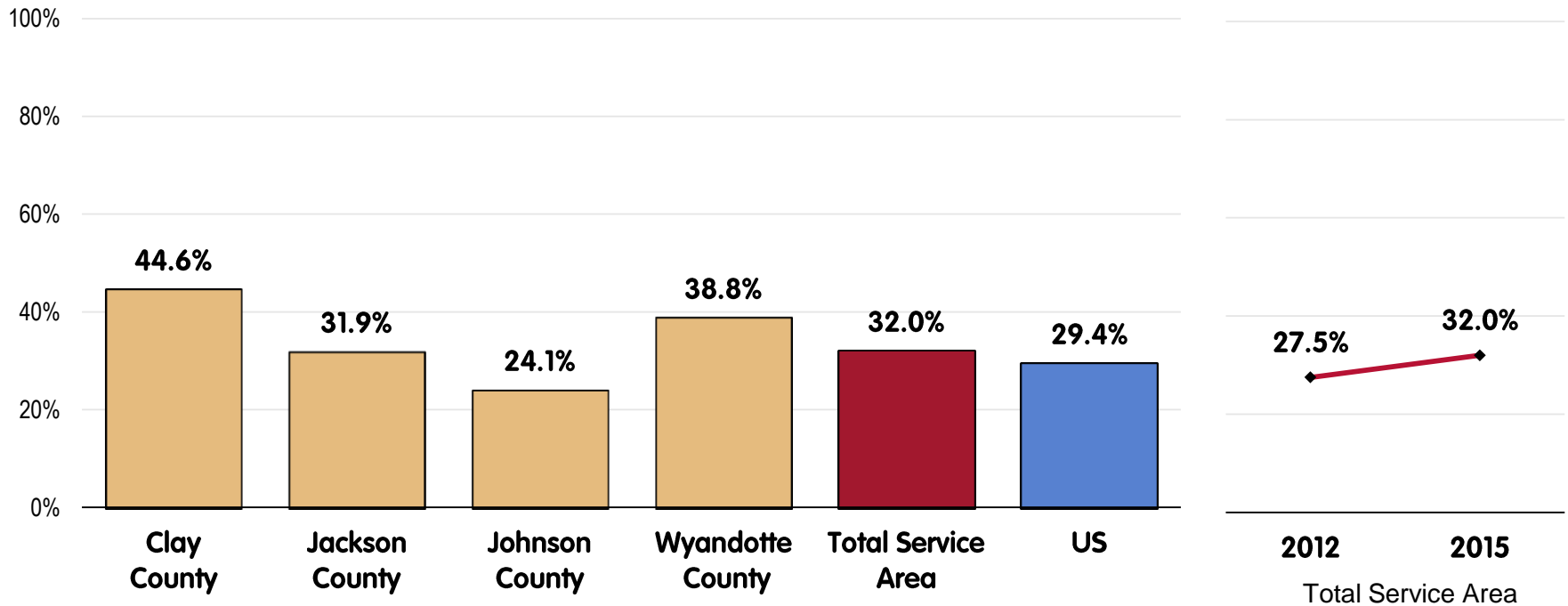
Particular Place Utilized for Child's Medical Care (Clay and Jackson Counties - MO & Johnson and Wyandotte Counties - KS, 2015)

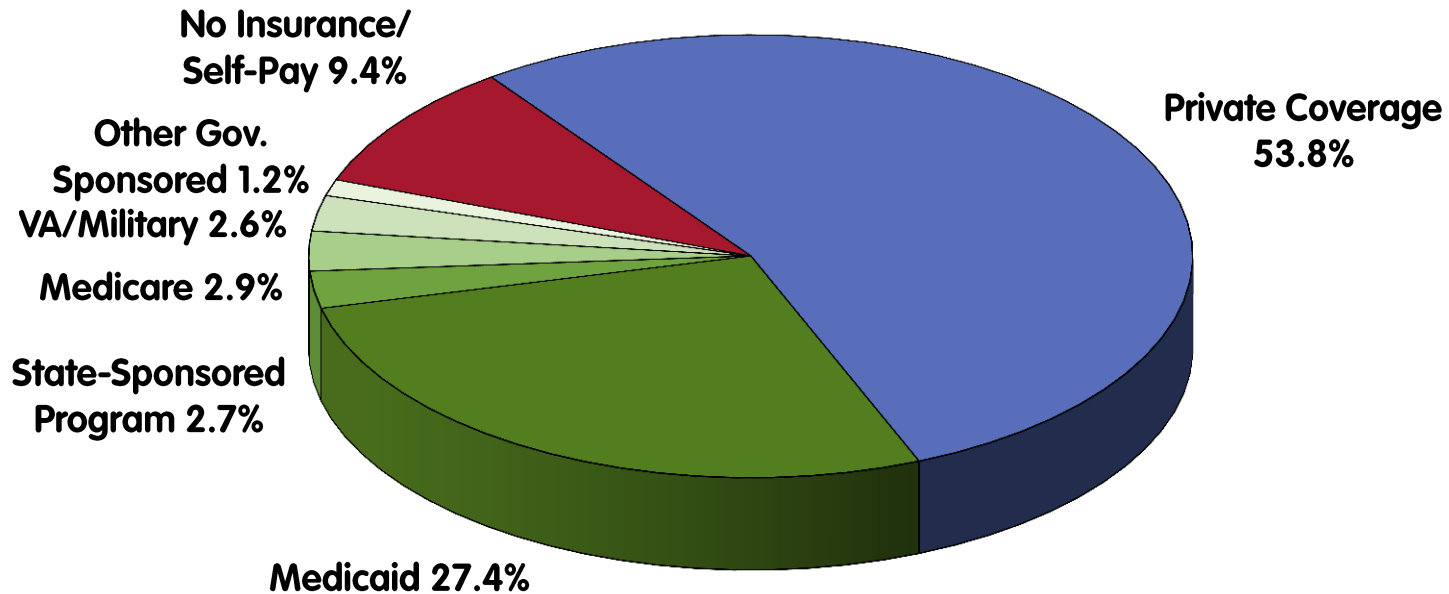
Represents the percentage of respondents experiencing one or more barriers to accessing their child's healthcare in the past 12 months.

Healthcare Insurance Coverage for Child

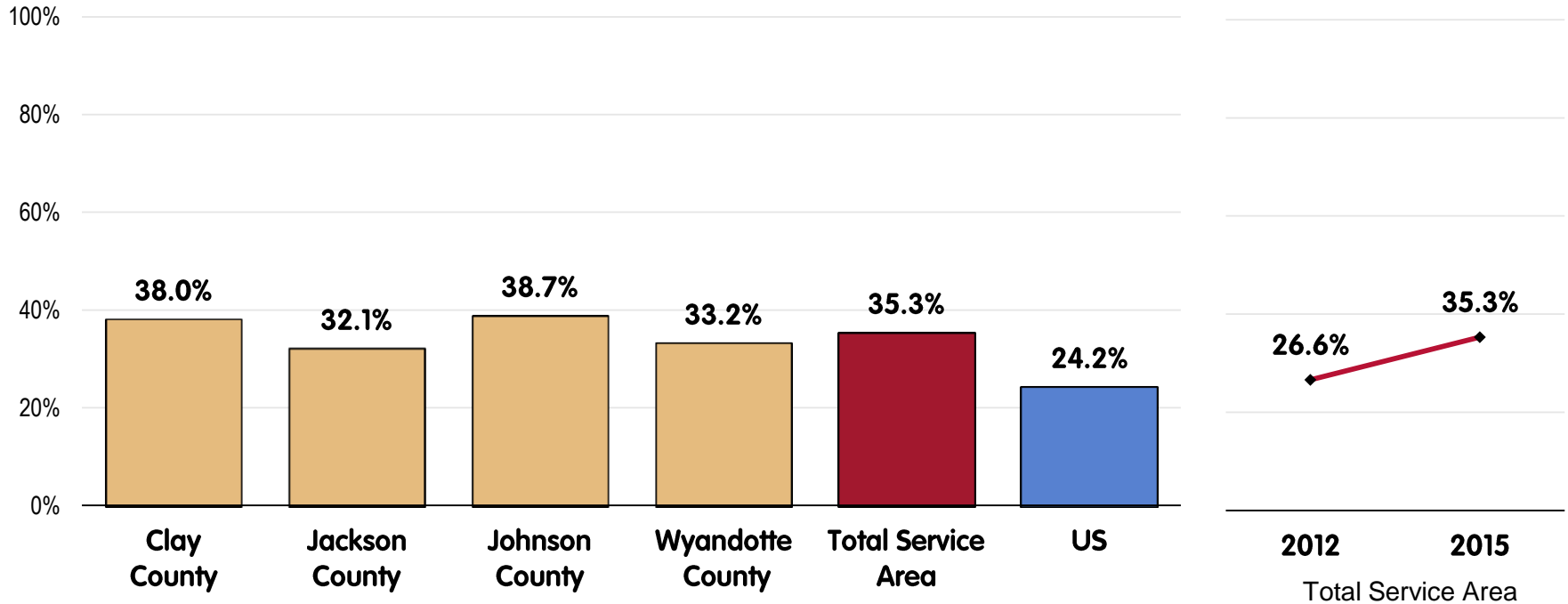

Child Needed a Specialist in the Past Year (By County, 2015)

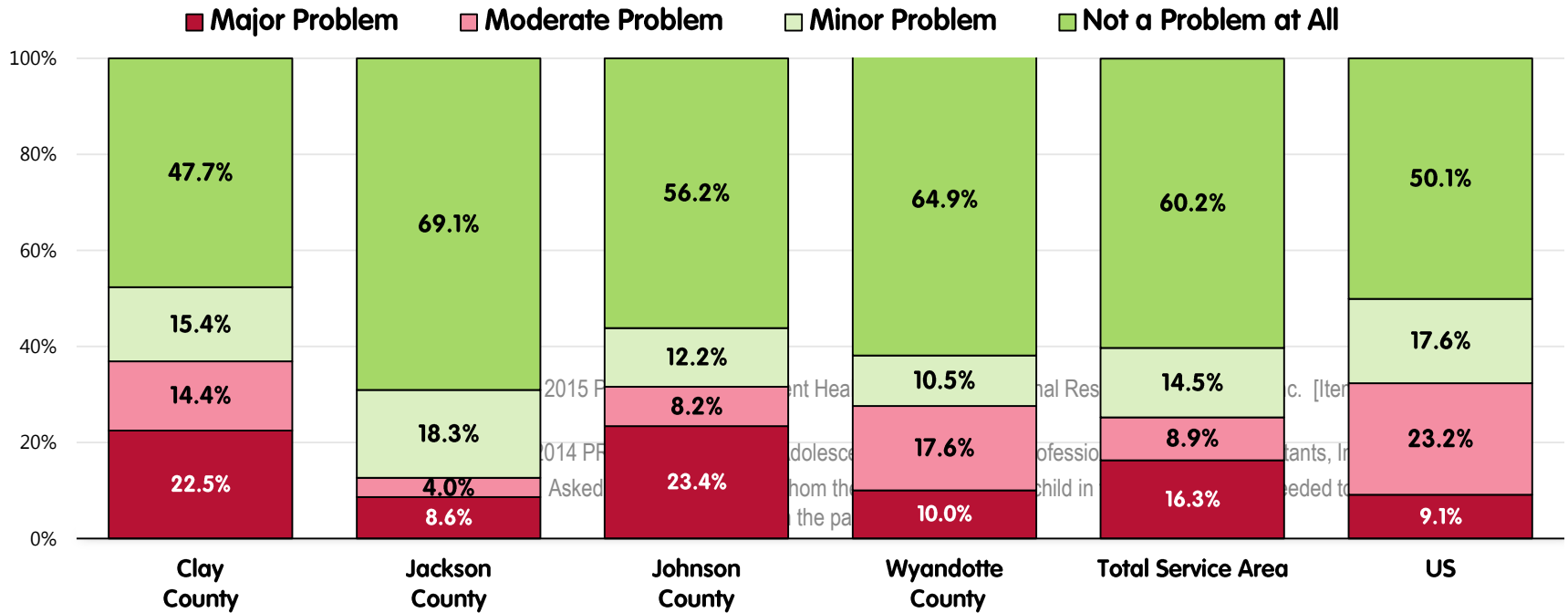

(By County, 2015)

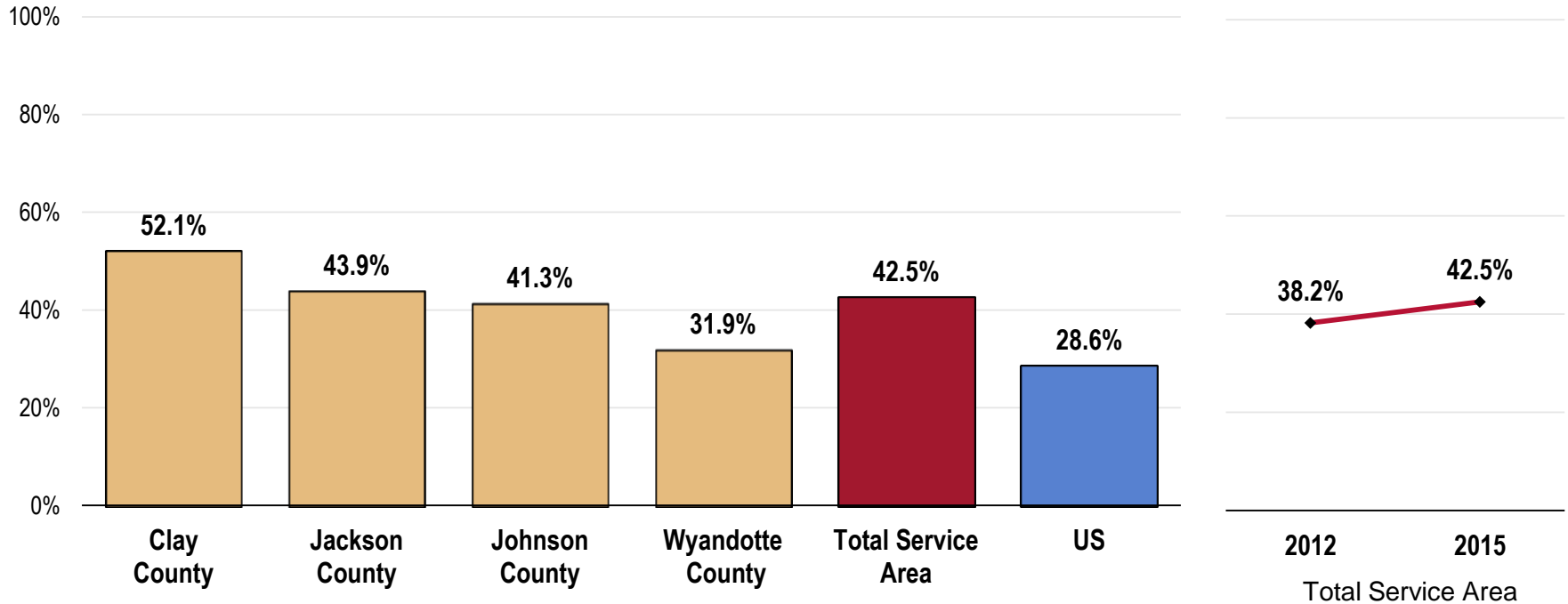

(Total Service Area, 2015)

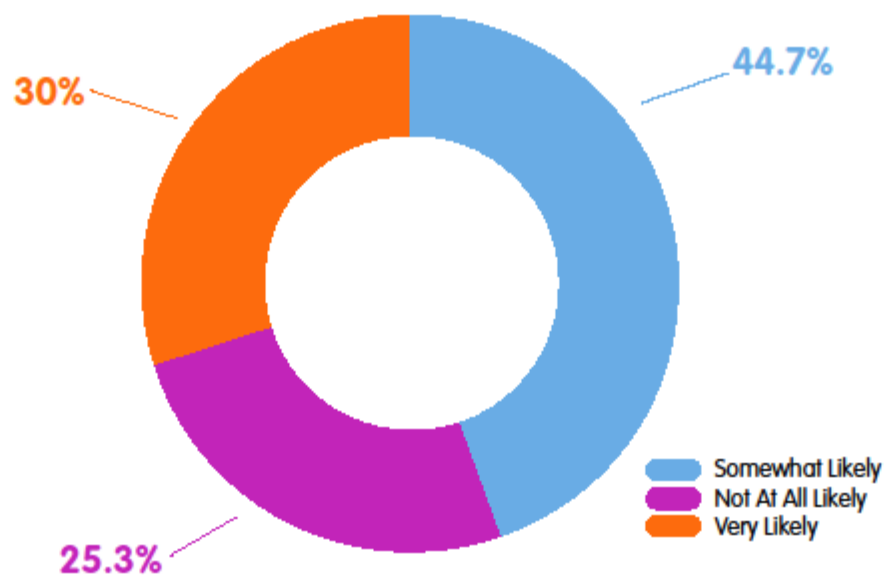
