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A 3.5 HOUR COURSE FOR PRIVATE DUTY NURSES AND SCHOOL NURSES ON TRACHEOSTOMY CARE AND MANAGEMENT

This is a didactic and hands-on course which will cover topics on routine tracheostomy care and changes, suctioning, patient assessment, troubleshooting, manual ventilation with a tracheostomy tube, a decision tree of how to manage emergency scenarios, and basic ventilator troubleshooting.

- Participants will demonstrate routine tracheostomy care and tracheostomy tube changes.
- Participants will analyze or discuss tracheostomy emergency situations and verbalize appropriate interventions.

- Participants will identify common ventilator alarms and verbalize appropriate interventions.
