





Log On to PHRED

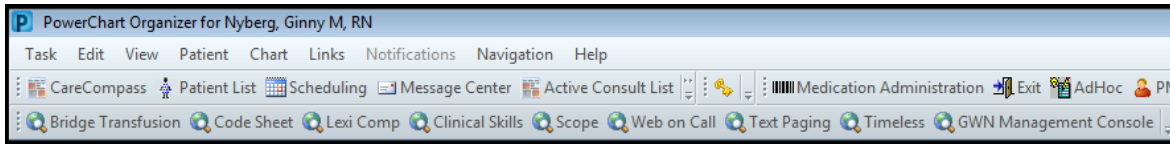
1. Double Click on PHRED Icon located on Desktop

MPages	View a brief summary of patient information and assessment.
Orders	View Current Orders to guide your care Under Display select <i>All Active Orders</i> 
I-View	Used for charting and view of I&O 24hr totals <u>View I&O Totals</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on I-View Section 2. Click on I&O Band (towards bottom) 3. Scroll to right to see last 24hr intake (blue columns)
Adverse Reactions	View reactions and allergies
MAR	Used for obtaining Med List & for Med Administration
MAR Summary	View last administered medication dose/time
Task List	Helps organize tasks to complete. Use this to document labs, & weights (unit/shift dependent). DO NOT document oral care or baths from here.
Documents	History & Physical, Progress Notes, Consult Notes, etc. If H&P is not listed – change time frame to look closer to admit date. (Right click on time range bar and select Change Search Criteria, Select dates around admit date.)
Results review	Change timeframe (use arrows to move date) Lab Results- double click on result to view normal high and low results Radiology Results (click on test to view results) Recent Results – View Clinical Documentation All Results Flow sheet
Growth Chart	<u>View Patient Weight & Height/Length (under 3 years)</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on Measurement 2. Click Table to view all entries

Vital signs	VS/Measurements/Focused Assessments, Vital Signs	Temp route, Monitored or unmonitored, cuff size, extremity, VS activity, VS position
Oxygen Saturation, Oxygen Delivery, Oximetry Site	Respiratory/Cardiovascular, Oxygen/Oximetry OR Vital Signs Site- Integumentary/Orthopaedic, Ox Site and/or digit	Delivery device, FiO2, O2 flow rate, Oximetry site and/or digit (must document site change minimally every 6 hours)
Wt, Ht, Head Circumference- dependent on unit/shift	VS/Measurements/Focused Assess., Measurements, Task List	Weights from Task List! (times done unit dependent)
Assessment	Assessments include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comfort • Neuro/Neuromuscular • Respiratory/Perfusion/Cardiovascular • GI/Nutrition/GU • Integumentary/Orthopedic • Tubes/Wounds • Arterial Venous Access 	Most System Assessments Norms can be found in Blue Text links. *Be sure to look in all boxes (blue & black) to make sure you don’t miss any normal or abnormal findings*
Suctioning	Respiratory/Cardiovascular, Airway Care/Suction	Type and description
SCD application	Respiratory/Cardiovascular, Cardiovascular (Interventions)	On/Off
Intake & Output or Pericare Product Used	GI/Nutrition/GU Pericare Product- Moisture Management	Type, route, amount, description, pericare & product used w/ every diaper change regardless of pt age.
Urinary Catheters	GI/Nutrition/GU, Catheter Urinary	Location, type, size, activity, prep, attempts, result, description, amount
NG & GT Care	GI/Nutrition/GU, Gastric Drainage Tubes	Type, size, location, intermittent or continuous feeding
Hygiene, Linens, Patient Position, Bathing, Pericare completed	Integumentary/Orthopaedic, Integumentary, Skin interventions	Bathing Type (soap & H2O, wipes, etc), mouth care, pericare, linen change, lead wires changed
Braces, Splints, Pin Care	Integumentary/Orthopaedic, Orthopaedic	On/Off as needed for braces/splints
Laboratory draws	Nursing Activities, Specimen Collection & Task List	Attempts, blood volume out. Document collection from Task List.
Urine Dipstick	Nursing Activities, Point of Care	
Patient Activities, Off Unit	Nursing Activities, Activities & Miscellaneous
