Q: What kind of car seat should this school age child be in?

A: It depends on the height/weight of the child; some children can still be rear-facing, and some might be big enough to use a seat belt. Here is a great website to help determine that <u>https://www.nhtsa.gov/equipment/car-seats-and-booster-seats#35091</u>.You can enter the child's age

and height and weight and it will tell you the best car seat to use for that child. On the backside of this is a 5 step test that a parent can use to see if their child is big enough to use an adult seatbelt.
